

2017 Balboa Park Sustainability Awards Application

Due: Friday, August 18 at 5 p.m.

The 2017 Balboa Park Sustainability Awards will recognize and honor Balboa Park organizations that have completed innovative sustainability projects in the past year. All finalists from previous years are encouraged to apply. However, no organization may **win** an award two consecutive years in a row.

To apply for the 2017 Balboa Park Sustainability Award, please complete the application below and email it with a minimum of one photo to sustainability@bpcp.org with "Balboa Park Sustainability Award Application | [Organization Name]" in the subject line.

CRITERIA:

- Applicant must be a member organization of the Balboa Park Cultural Partnership.
- The project must have been initiated, active or completed within the last year. (September 2016-August 2017)
- An organization may submit for more than one project, however a separate application must be completed for each project.
- No one organization can win an award for two consecutive years.
 - o Award finalists in previous years may be winners or finalists in 2017.
 - o 2015 award winners may be winners or finalists in 2017.
 - 2016 award winners will only qualify as finalists in 2017, but are not eligible to be award winners.
- If a previously submitted project is submitted again in 2017, there must be a clear demonstration of improvement or progression of the project goals and outcomes.
- All applications must be submitted by the Friday, August 18 at 5 p.m. deadline.

SCORING:

The Balboa Park Sustainability Council and Nomination Committee will review all applications for (a) completeness of the application, (b) confirmation that all criteria is met and (c) weighted total score based on the scorecard below.
