FORMAL EDUCATION

Professional Development: We support professional development of Park staff in many ways, including helping Balboa Park team members receive Building Operators Certifications (BOC) and IFMA's Sustainability Facility Professional (SFP) certifications.

Community Workshops: Our program provides innovative and specialized training for Balboa Park staff, volunteers and the community about sustainability principles and practices.

Green Impact Guide: In partnership with San Diego State University, the Green Impact Guide was created to provide the Park's diverse arts, science, and cultural organizations a tool to successfully implement sustainability best practices.
