

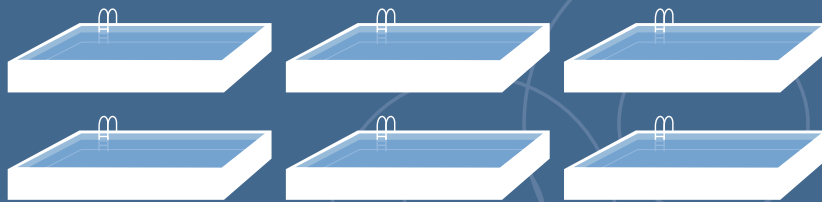
WATER CONSERVATION

The Balboa Park Sustainability Program works with member organizations and community partners to reduce water consumption at the building level. Collectively, since 2012, these partnerships have saved an estimated 4+ million gallons of water in Balboa Park by installing low-flow restroom fixtures including aerators, toilets, urinals, and flow control valves.

A SMALL CHANGE MAKES A BIG DIFFERENCE

The installation of faucet aerators restricts the flow of water for hand washing. Changing one aerator can save 0.2 to 1.5 gallons of water per use.

Since 2012, Balboa Park's efforts have saved the equivalent of **6** olympic swimming pools.



We encourage change at the organization level through awareness and education. Past educational workshop topics have included Water Management Best Practices and Water Harvesting.
