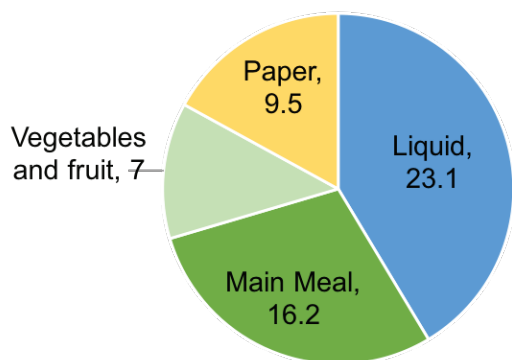
Food Waste Diversion Report
